



## **Rabbit Runner**

Rabit runners provide the ultimate in versatility and convenience. They can be worn over the shoulder like a normal full-length runner, but instead of pulling the sling over your head and arm, just unclip one of the loops and slide it right off. No more worrise about getting your slings stuck undernenth your rack, or flighting with over-the-shoulder slings that won't pull off over your helmet or don't fit over your prake. Lip both loops together an one end for a standard 22" runner or use it full-length tor 44" of extension. Tying off trees, blocks, icides, or horns, and equalizing beloys has never been easier.

No webbing currently available could meet the unique demands of rabbit runners so we developed our own. Ultra-strong Metolius Power-Webbing™ blends Spectra and nylon fibers in a unique configuration to give the best properties of all other webbing types combined.

## Metolius Power-Webbing™ provides:

- 5000 lbf. single-strand breaking strength (Most webbing requires a double strand or loop to achieve this strength.)
- Higher UV resistance than pure nylon slings
- Lower water absorption than pure nylon slings
- Higher cutting resistance than pure nylon slings
- Lighter weight than pure nylon slings
- Higher abrasion resistance than pure Spectra slings (Normal Spectra has a lower abrasion resistance than nylon, so we put a high concentration of nylon fibers at the edge of the webbing, the area most prone to abrasion.)

Never clip the sewn loops in such a way that they can be loaded in multiple directions.
